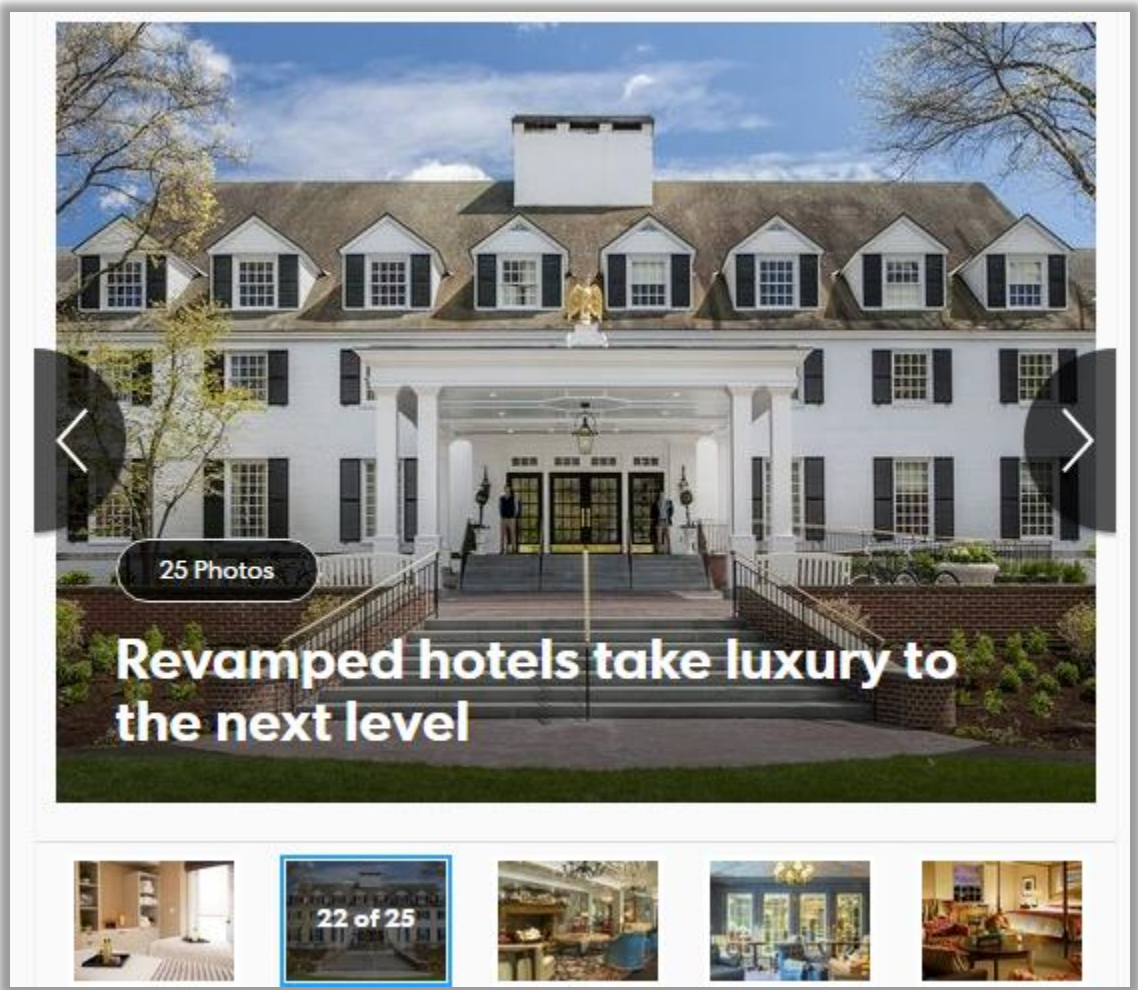


Six recently revamped luxury USA hotels

Woodstock Inn & Resort

In spring 2016, the Woodstock Inn & Resort underwent a \$3.5 million renovation. Follow the glossy black doors leading into a black and white marble vestibule, continuing into a lobby-turned-New England Federal-period living room filled with artifacts and artwork from the private Rockefeller archives. Herringbone American walnut flooring, coffered ceilings and a fireplace with ottoman enhance the ambiance, though a separate lounge with Schumacher brocade wallpaper is also a nice place to sip a cocktail or enjoy seated check-in. Head into the renovated Library, with the centerpiece being a cabinet paying homage to the heritage of the property and the role of the Rockefellers in its creation, and try a made-in-Vermont wooden puzzle or read a bestseller. The onsite fine dining Red Rooster also received new floral artwork and lamps to pair with the new menus sourcing from the resort's 2.5-acre certified organic gardens.
