New Brunswick, Canada



Head to this Canadian Maritime province for leaf peeping, fall festivals, and the end of whale watching season. Hotel and airfare prices are much lower in the fall than they are over the summer months, but be sure to head to the region earlier in the season for warmer temps.

Why It's a Steal: Average airfares from New York City and Boston range between \$250 to \$350 for the fall months, according to [Orbitz](#) and [Expedia](#), and hotel room rates average \$100 to \$200 per night at four-star properties.

Don't Miss: Fall festivals are Canada's specialty, and New Brunswick offers plenty—check out the [Harvest Jazz and Blues Festival](#) and [Indulge](#) (a food and wine festival in St. Andrews). For outdoor activities enjoy [whale watching](#), [Fundy National Park](#) (offering free entry for the country's 150th anniversary), farmers' markets, and fantastic foliage that's seen best by paddling down the [Miramichi River](#) or driving the Appalachian Range route.
